Needs Attention	Safety and Display
	Project # in upper right corner
	Project Size –30” deep, 48 “ wide, 108” from floor to top of project; project extends in front of table beyond dimensions
	Awards, medals, business cards, flags, endorsements, acknowledgments to be removed
	Official abstract upright in a simple frame in front of or on display board (no unofficial abstract on board)
	Official abstract not signed by student. Abstract not dated by student.
	Other forms required to be vertically displayed if applicable – 1C, Form 7
	Photos sources cited for use: internet image needs credit; pictures from magazine, book, or other requires source cited. Citations on display board.
	Signed consent Form 4 required at project for human behavior project; signed consent Form 4 for displayed photos required
	photographs of vertebrate animals in surgical techniques, dissections, necropsies, or other lab procedures prohibited
	Remove from project: plants, soil, chemicals, water, biological specimen, food, tissue, microorganisms, sharp items, high temperature items (soil can be permanently encased in acrylic)
	Unshielded belts, pulleys, chains, moving part must be display only and not operated
	Cover bare wires, voltage over 120 or 220, safety hazard, soldering needed, clearly visible on/off switch or disconnect not visible,
	Class II laser disconnected or labeled “laser radiations Do NOT LOOK into Beam”; enclosed in protective housing
	Class II, IV laser for display only and cannot be functional
	Apparatus producing high or extremely low temperatures that will cause harm prohibited
	Batteries-open top cells prohibited and must be removed
	Glass or glass objectives prohibited unless integral necessary part of project such as part of a commercial product such as a computer screen.
